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The **Harvey Senior High School Uniform Policy** meets the requirements of recommended policy of the WA Department of Education and State Government legislation. Any future alteration or modification of the Dress Code will require community consultation.

The School Dress Code:

- Sets a clear, acceptable, and consistent standard of dress for all students and parents:
- Fosters and enhances the public image of the school;
- Assists in building school and team spirit.
- Ensures students are safely dressed for specific school activities.
- Encourages equity among students:
- Prepares students for work, as many workplaces have dress and safety codes; and
- Allows for easy identification of intruders into the school during the school day.

Modifications to Dress Code:

- Students who for religious or health reasons may need to modify the school dress code are required to make an appointment with the principal or a designated staff member. Staff will be informed of any student granted a modification to the dress code.
- Garments bearing brand names, logos and stripes (eg. Adidas, Nike) are NOT allowed.
- Board shorts, thongs, etc. are NOT allowed.

Non-compliance:

- Students not complying with the dress code will be reminded of meeting uniform requirements. They will be directed to report to Student Services (B1) where students will be required to change into appropriate clothing provided by the school.
