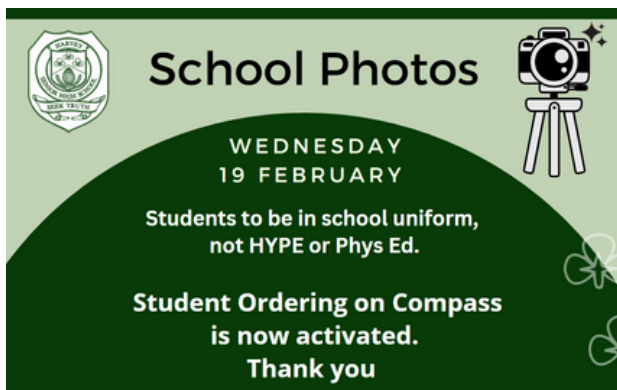
These roles have been introduced recently to enhance curriculum implementation, academic support, and pastoral care, ensuring the best possible learning experience for our students.
